The comprehensive expertise and technology available encompasses magnetic resonance imaging (MRI), ultrasound, computed radiography (CR), fluoroscopy and echocardiography. These sophisticated modalities, which can be used individually or in combination, provide high quality images which represent invaluable tools for diagnosis, treatment or interventional radiology (IR). The imaging facilities are available to our clinicians 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and are essential to provide prompt and accurate diagnoses for referring vets, their clients and our patients.

Our Diagnostic Imaging Service is headed by Sam Jakovljevic, DipECVDI, supported by a team of radiologists and radiographers. The team regularly provides training for veterinarians wishing to specialise and obtain a post graduate qualification at either the Certificate or the Diploma level.
