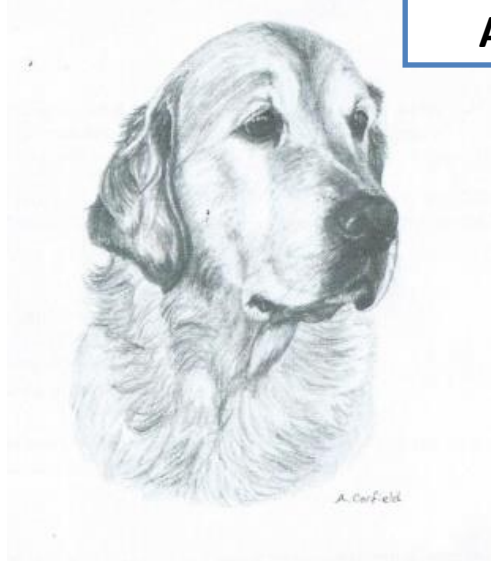

## DATA PROTECTION

From May18 there will be considerable revisions to Data Protection regulations in the UK and whilst small clubs like the SGRS will remain exempt from full DPA registration, the new regulations impose a greater responsibility concerning data collection and retention.

As a result, it has become necessary to now add a Data Protection Policy to the SGRS website and to include certain statements into the Membership Application form.

Obviously as an existing member, you need to be made aware of these changes, as below. Membership of the SGRS requires retention of your Name, Address, Telephone Number, E-mail Address and (if appropriate) Kennel Name. The SGRS will retain this information, on a rolling basis, for a maximum of 3 years prior to the current membership year.

Inclusion within the SGRS Judges Lists requires retention of your Name, Address, Telephone Number, E-mail Address and (if appropriate) Kennel Name. The SGRS will retain this information, on a rolling basis, for a maximum of 3 years prior to the current membership year.

Your details will only be used for the purposes of communicating information about SGRS activities and will not be shared with any other organisation except, if so requested, by the Kennel Club.

Detailed Judges Lists will only be shared with other Canine Societies, upon request, and the Kennel Club. Only Judges' names will appear on the SGRS website.

The SGRS does not process your information for any other purpose than to communicate with you.

Individuals may apply in writing to the Secretary to enquire as to what information is held about them and this information must be provided within 40 days of the date of the request. Individuals may also request that any part of their details be deleted from the database.

## Membership Form Agreement

I/We also agree to the SGRS holding on its database my/our name, address, telephone number, e-mail address and kennel names (if applicable). I/We also understand that:

- the information held on the SGRS membership database will only be used by the SGRS for the purposes of

communicating information about club activities. This list will be made available to the Kennel Club, upon request.

- this personal information will be retained for a maximum of 3 years on a rolling basis prior to the current membership year.
- the SGRS does not process your information for any other purpose than to communicate with me/us.
- the list of current SGRS members may be requested from the Secretary (as above) by any SGRS member but under no circumstances may be shared or transmitted to any other individual or organisation.
- at any time I/we may apply in writing to the Secretary (as above) to establish what information is held about me/us and this information will be provided within 40 days of the date of the request. Additionally, a request to delete any part of this information can be made at any time.
